What is it? K.I.D. Leadership Training is 3 days of intensive training to equip you to direct Kids In Discipleship in your home church. KID is a ministry for parents and children between the ages of 7 - 17.

When is it? K.I.D. Leadership Training will be offered again in 2013, May 9 – 12 starting at 8.30pm on Thursday and ending mid afternoon on Sunday.

Where is it? Venue to be confirmed.

How do we register and what are the requirements? K.I.D Leadership Training is designed to prepare teams to introduce and lead K.I.D. in their home church.

- 1. Each team must include five persons consisting of the pastor, elder and three lay-leaders from **one** church.
- 2. Prior to registration, conduct the congregation and church board surveys.
- 3. Fill in the application form with the results of the surveys, the names of your team members and their email address and a financial guarantee from the church treasurer. (Survey's and application forms can be obtained from the Union Children's Ministries department or downloaded from the BUC website: www.adventistinfo.org.uk/departments/childrensministries.php.

- 5. Churches who meet the above mentioned requirements qualify for enrolment. Once your team has been accepted for the training the church team leader has to confirm participation to the above address and the registration is then binding and the fee non-refundable.
- 6. The full amount of the registration fee should then be paid through the church channels to the British Union Conference. (Cheques payable to *British Union Conference*.)

What is the Cost? For a team of 5 persons the *Registration fee is £950. If you register* early by January 30th 2013 the fee is £800. Apply to your Conference/Mission as they will contribute towards the fees. This includes instruction, training manuals, resource materials as well as meals and accommodation during the training period. If a sixth person joins your team the additional cost will be £200.
