

Fearfully & Wonderfully Made

The retina of the eye has rods (120 million black and white sensors) and cones (6 million colour sensors). Cones in our central vision detect colour - our peripheral vision is largely black and white (try it and see!). With this the human eye is able to distinguish between 100 million different shades and colours. However the Bible tells us

1 Cor 3:12 - We don't yet see things clearly. We're squinting in a fog, peering through a mist. But it won't be long before the weather clears and the sun shines bright! We'll see it all then, see it all as clearly as God sees us, knowing him directly just as he knows us!

Science confirms this to be true as many animals - especially birds - can also see colours in the ultraviolet range. So the plain bird we see as brown may truly not be!
