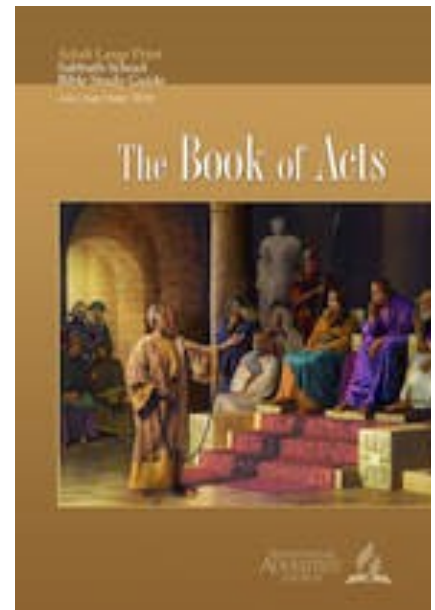

Sabbath School begins at 9:30am.


Children's Sabbath School begins at 9:45am in the hall.

Deafness

Hearing, or auditory perception, is the ability to perceive sounds by detecting vibrations. The human range is commonly given as 20 to 20,000 Hz. Some dolphins and bats, for example, can hear frequencies up to 100,000 Hz. Elephants can hear sounds at 14–16 Hz, while some whales can hear infrasonic sounds as low as 7 Hz.

The Bible does mention deaf people infrequently.

The first specific person in the Bible who we are told was deaf was the man healed by Jesus in Mark 7:32

The first deaf person in the Bible may have been John the Baptist's father, Zechariah. We know he was mute (Luke 1:20) leading up to John's birth, but it seems he may also have been deaf as his neighbours needed to communicate in sign to him (Luke 1:62)
