



## **Fearfully & Wonderfully Made**

### **Short stature**

Chandra Bahadur Dangi (30 November 1939 – 3 September 2015) in Nepal was the shortest man in recorded history for whom there is irrefutable evidence. He measured just 54.6 cm (1 ft 9 1/2 in)

The Bible mentions people of short stature too.

A common answer is Zacchaeus based on Luke 19:2, which tells us that he was a short man. Recall that he was concerned that he would not be able to see Jesus when He passed by. So Zacchaeus remedied his problem by climbing into a sycamore tree. Some might suggest James, the cousin of our Lord and the author of the Epistle of James, might be shorter than Zacchaeus since he is referred to in Scripture as “James the less” (Mark 15:40)

Others will suggest that a shorter man than Zacchaeus or James was Nehemiah since names in Scripture often had significance and his name, knee-high-miah, obviously indicates he was very short.....

But considering the names of Biblical characters, some people might point out that Nehemiah was obviously a giant compared to Bildad who was a shuhite (shoe-height) and therefore obviously shorter than a knee-high individual (Job 2:11).
