




SABBATH SCHOOL

Fingernails and toenails are made of a tough protective protein called alphakeratin. This protein is also found in hooves and horns of animals. They are

finger; and fingernails grow up to four times faster than toenails. In humans, nails grow at an average rate of 3 mm (0.12 in) a month and so fingernails require three to six months to regrow completely, and toenails require twelve to eighteen months. The longest female nails to ever exist measure a total of 601.9 cm
