

Sabbath School begins at 9:30am.


Children's Sabbath School begins at 9:45am in the hall.

	somewhat until you	ability to discern right from wrong. Although, that ability is hindered connect with your Creator. He didn't just design you to do your own thing. ou would desire an ongoing relationship with Him.	

You were made with a hole in the centre of your soul that only one thing fits. Until you find that very specific something, you will never be fulfilled. And that very specific something is God Himself. You were designed with an intense need of your Creator, God. Without a relationship with Him, you will always be searching for something to fill that void.

Drugs, alcohol, food, money, sex, material goods, occupations, hobbies, travel, success, fame these are some of the ways in which we try to fill that empty space inside. But none of those things will ever fill it. They are like round pegs in square holes. The vacant areas at the edges will still leave you desiring more of something else. Whatever you attempt to put in there will dissipate because it never completely fills the space. Those things were never meant to fill the space; they never can.

Sadly, many continue to shove mismatched pegs into that hole. If you're not happy with who you are today, right here and right now, you'll never be. You'll never be happy with who you are today unless you begin to praise God for creating you just as you are.
