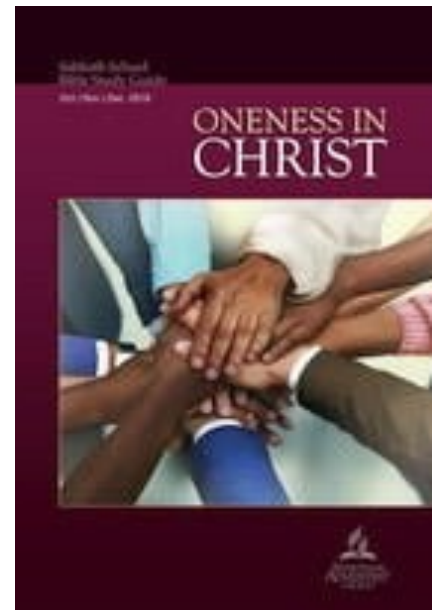

### **Fearfully & Wonderfully Made**

Psychology textbooks state that on a clear, dark night our eyes can spot a candle flame from as far away as 48 kilometres while the absolute farthest object we can see with our naked eye is outside of our galaxy: the Andromeda Galaxy, located 2.5 million light years from us, or a cool 23 quintillion miles - that's 18 zeros!
